My Sister's adds store location in San Diego

20-year-old firm with 10 Valley stores adds office space

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THE RETAILERS

The local consignment company provides three types of shops for your recycled needs.

Women's apparel: My Sister's Closet, five stores.

Men's apparel: Well Suited, three stores.

Furniture and home furnishings: My Sister's Attic, four stores.

THE RULES

- » Clothing, accessories and furnishings should be no more than 4 to 5 years old. Vintage, antique or retro items are an exception.
- » Clothing must be wrinkle-free, clean and on hangers. No spots, rips, stains.
- » Clothing accepted by season: fall items starting in mid-August and spring items starting in January.
- » Accessories: Costume and fine jewelry, sunglasses, shoes, vintage bags and vintage jewelry, western wear, hats, scarves and new perfume/cologne.
- » Purses and wallets: In like-new condition and clean, must be authentic designer; no fake designer handbags.
